University of Crete: one of the [Best Universities in Europe 2017](#)

On Wednesday 21st June, *Times Higher Education (THE)* published a new analysis on the performance of European universities. The ranking is based on just under 400 European universities included in the [THE World University Rankings 2016-2017](#). It uses previously unpublished data drawn from the 13 separate performance indicators that make up the *THE* WUR. These are designed to measure the performance of research-intensive universities in teaching, research output and impact, knowledge transfer and international outlook.

Six Greek Universities are represented in this European ranking. Compared with last year, University of Crete holds its position in the 171-180 band and is, to date, the only Greek University included in the top 200 European Universities.
